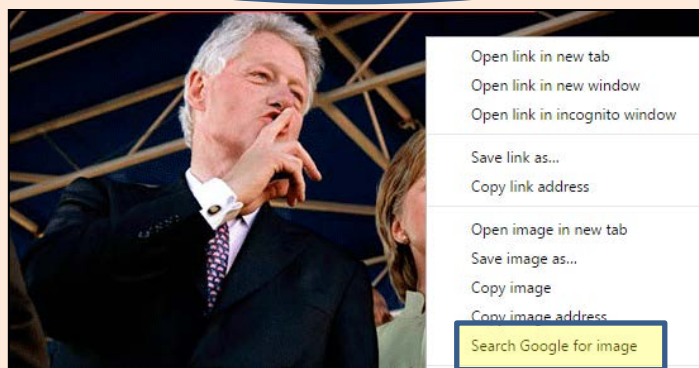
FAKE Ask Yourself

1. Does the story come from a strange URL?
2. Does the headline match the article information?
3. Is it a recent story or has an old story been repurposed?
4. Are the supporting videos and photos verifiable? Do an image search.
5. Does the article cite primary sources?
6. Does the story feature traceable quotes?
7. Is there only one outlet reporting this story?
8. Is your own bias getting in the way?
9. Has it been debunked by a reputable fact checking organization?
10. Is the host on a list of unreliable websites?

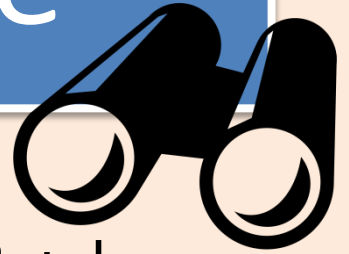

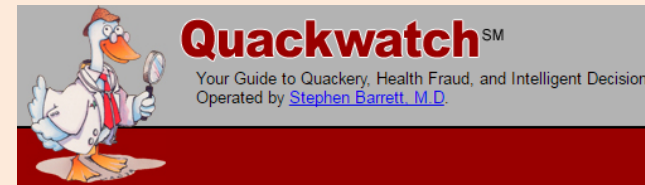
Search results come from a list of credible resources, including primary sources. They exclude obvious spam sites, and marginal sites that read well, but lack academic or journalistic rigor.
